4. Police Department Report – Dillon presented 33 calls, 21 ordinance violations (door hanger), 8 tickets, 4 arrest, 4 warnings




8. Gary Bosworth & Marcus Miiller had written letters asking for sewer credits because of leaks. Jim made motion 2nd by Trisha. Unanimous
